To: William Prout, a Resident in the Town of Topsham. You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters in the Town of Topsham of the election described in this warrant and notice of election.

TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF TOPSHAM:

You are hereby notified that a School Administrative District No. 75 Budget Validation Referendum election will be held at Mt. Ararat High School, in the Town of Topsham on June 9, 2026, for the purpose of determining the following referendum question:

Question 1: Do you favor authorizing the board of directors of School Administrative District No. 75 (the "District") to issue bonds and notes and other evidences of indebtedness in the name of the District in an amount not to exceed \$102,100 through the State of Maine's zero interest rate/loan forgiveness School Revolving Renovation Fund (SRRF) Program for installation of a fully accessible ADA-compliant restroom at Bowdoin Central School (the "Project")?

The following Project information is provided as part of this Question 1:

- A.. Project Explanation: The Project involves renovating a storage space at Bowdoin Central School into a fully accessible restroom that is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Project will enable the District to provide

private, functional and safe restroom facilities for special education students with complex needs.

- B. Financing Explanation: The Project costs up to a maximum of \$102,100 have been approved for funding through Maine's zero interest rate/loan forgiveness SRRF Program. Of this amount, the District will receive 54.24% (up to \$55,379) that will be forgiven, and 45.76% (up to \$46,721) that the District will repay at zero interest (0%) over a term of five years.

The voting on Question 1 shall be by secret ballot referendum. The polls will be opened at 8:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.



A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.


